



## Boglarka Gyorgy - Violinist

A spark of passion for music ignited by Bizet's Carmen, led violinist Boglarka Gyorgy to pursue a career as an artist from a young age. She is a graduate of the Liszt Academy of Music, Budapest. Originally from Hungary, Boglarka has also called Israel home. Music making has subsequently taken her to many countries. She is currently based in Birmingham, England.

Boglarka has a particular passion for contemporary music and as such, often plays with the Birmingham Contemporary Music Group where she has worked with many composers including Brian Ferneyhough and Gyorgy Kurtag.

In 2017 she gave her orchestra debut playing Bartok 2nd Violin Concerto with the Savaria Symphony Orchestra and she also had the privilege of working with conductors such as Zubin Mehta and Zoltan Kocsis.

As a recitalist, Boglarka has performed extensively throughout Europe and Asia, and at festivals such as Keshet Eilon, ISA Semmering, Lichfield Festival and the 11th International Music Festival in Moscow.

Boglarka is performing on a violin by Cuypers from 1797, kindly on loan to her from the Harrison-Frank Family Foundation.
